


For I know the plans I have for you,

Only half of the children we serve will have an evening meal at home, and only about half of those will have enough to be satisfied. Before Trinity HOPE provided a noon meal at school, the children were too hungry to learn and couldn't concentrate on school work. They were unhealthy and often missed school. There were signs of malnutrition (rust colored hair, blank stares, and tiny bodies). They were described as having no hope.



As the children are fed, they become healthier and no longer suffer from malnutrition. They learn better and see the food as a witness to the truth of the Good News shared daily by their teachers and pastor.



HAITI FACTS


- Poorest country in the Western Hemisphere
- \$500/year is the average income
- 62% of the Haitians live on \$1.25 or less per day
- Acute malnutrition is 500% higher than in the U.S.
- Infant mortality rate is 840% higher than in the U.S.
- About 60 to 65% practice Voodoo
- 35% are Christians (up from 20% in the last decade and a half)

has provided a physical, mental, emotional and spiritual lifeline for thousands of children.



Nutrition

Children receive a nutritious bowl of rice (or corn) and beans, with a high-protein sauce developed by a Vanderbilt University nutritionist. This one daily meal costs approximately \$0.25 and will totally change the lives of these children.

Faith

Every school Trinity HOPE feeds is a Christian school, actively teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ on a regular basis.


Education
